Each camper chose a word that represented a trait they wanted to change or a characteristic they wanted in their lives. These words included; anger, forgiveness, hope, leader and responsibility.

Some of these young men have never known their fathers, had their fathers in their lives only when convenient or had fathers who have dealt with addiction and/or have been in and out of prison. One camper that was adopted very young, had just been able to make contact with his biological mom before she was recently murdered. Another camper has dealt with his mom being in and out of rehab his entire life.

All our young men have dealt with tough

beginnings in their young lives but they all learned that their Heavenly Father will never leave nor forsake them. They also were each given a quote from the late Pat Summitt, The Lady Vols basketball coach for 38 years. She used to tell her athletes, **"Your life to this point is what it is but it will become what you choose it to be**".

This is a profound statement that we pray each of our campers takes on as a challenge for their own lives.

Come as you are, but be challenged to change.

"[My son now knows] that there really is a God who loves him. That because of Jesus' sacrifice he is saved no matter what has happened in the past."
