We also had a completely new counseling staff, with the exception of JP and Joe. There was never a dull moment! The campers enjoyed a wide variety of events and excursions, including a 3 night camping trip and hike to Lilly Lake, white water rafting, a hike over the Mosca Pass to the Great Sand Dunes National Park and ending at the Zapata Falls, and a trip to Mission Wolf. They had archery competitions and over the line games, fished and played board games. They even learned basic car maintenance, ie. changing oil and a flat tire. They worshiped and had quiet times and one on one times with their mentors as they did a study on the book of Nehemiah. They learned that they have a loving heavenly father and that there is freedom in forgiveness. They learned that Jesus is the perfect example of what a good father is and should be. We spent Father's Day together and while many of them had a tainted views of what this day should represent, they heard about Jesus and how He is our heavenly father, the only one who will never abandon us or let us down.



A part of each day was spent doing a work project here on the Ranch. We spent time clearing the trail between the boys cabin and the main cabin where the boys came for their meals and for worship. It was a good summer that came with it's own challenges, but we know that God is so good to take our obstacles and work them together for the good of those who are called according to His purpose. On day one every one showed up with their wall up and their heart guarded but as the weeks progressed we saw walls come down and hearts exposed. They bonded together and worked together, they encouraged one another, and laughed together. They cried together and shared what was on their hearts.

Our new counseling staff was great! They were challenged at times but it was evident that they were here to show these boys the love of Christ and

As we look toward the future of the N-X Ranch we see God moving in some exciting ways! Lord willing, we are planning to break ground in the Spring of 2018 for our new camp facility. This facility would accommodate 20 campers at a time as well as additional staff. We have hopes of using the camp as a retreat center for single moms and as a mentoring center for moms and dads to learn how to parent God's way. The total projected cost for this facility is one Million dollars, with \$150,000 already given toward this effort.
